

We look forward to seeing you at our office tomorrow! As we have mentioned in previous communications, there are some important safety precautions that we have implemented and we would like to review those with you now.

- In order to help facilitate social distancing in our office/waiting room we ask that only 1 person accompany a child to an appointment. Please have siblings and other family members stay home.
- We ask that you and your child (if he or she is old enough to tolerate it) wear a facemask to the appointment. A regular mask or homemade fabric mask is perfect! Please have your masks on BEFORE entering the office.
- Please use the hand sanitizer stationed at the front door before proceeding to check-in with Aubrey at the front desk.
- Coronavirus screening: Below you will find our COVID-19 screening questions. This screening will be done upon your arrival to our office, but please take a moment to review the questions now as well. For the safety of our other patients and our staff, please be candid in your answers. If any of these questions are answered in the affirmative, we will need to reschedule your appointment. Additionally, we will be using a No-Contact Infrared Thermometer to take the temperature of all of our patients and their guardians. Anyone with a temperature exceeding 100.4 degrees F will be rescheduled.

Screening Questions (applicable to both the patient and the guardian):

- 1. Have you had a fever or felt hot/feverish in the past 14-21 days?**
- 2. Have you had shortness of breath or other breathing difficulties?**
- 3. Do you have a cough? Runny nose? Sore throat?**
- 4. Have you experienced a recent loss of taste or smell?**
- 5. Have you had any flu-like symptoms (GI upset/headache/fatigue)?**
- 6. Have you been in contact with any confirmed COVID-19 positive patients?**
- 7. Within the last 14 days, have you traveled to a foreign country or within the US? If so, where?**
